A shelter is one of the basic needs that everybody in the world must have. <u>FORM Design Collaborative</u> has created the Woodland <u>Canopy</u>, an <u>eco-friendly shelter</u> that has floor platforms that are made of locally obtained and FSC certified or reclaimed lumber. It also has a ribbed structure that is constructed using an unprocessed <u>bamboo canes lashed</u> together with hemp rope. In addition, the woodland canopy is constructed for sustainable materials and it has <u>low impact connection</u> to the site for an easy removal of the structure if desired. With the great features of the Woodland Canopy, I find it perfect for a weekend overnight outing or can be a temporary shelter for survival if needed.
